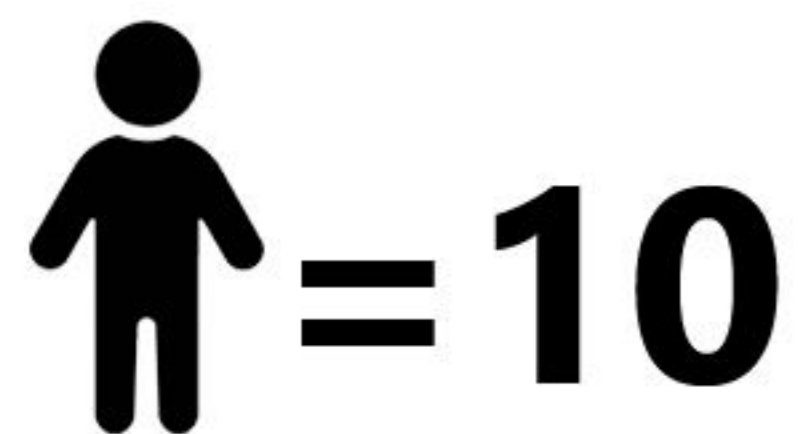
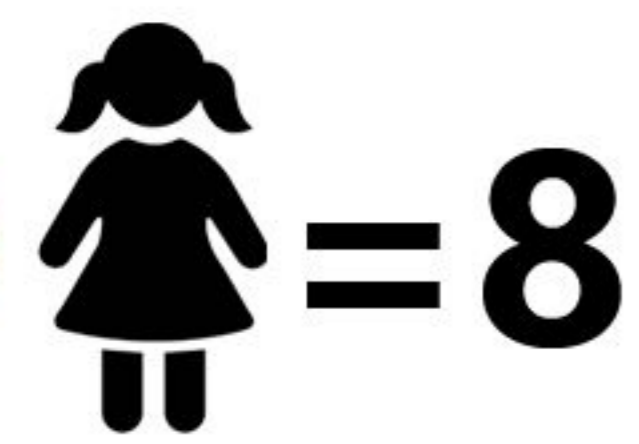
Education Program

We provided support for children by providing them with all necessary school supplies, including school fees, uniforms, shoes, notebooks, bags, and even mattresses, transportations for secondary school students.

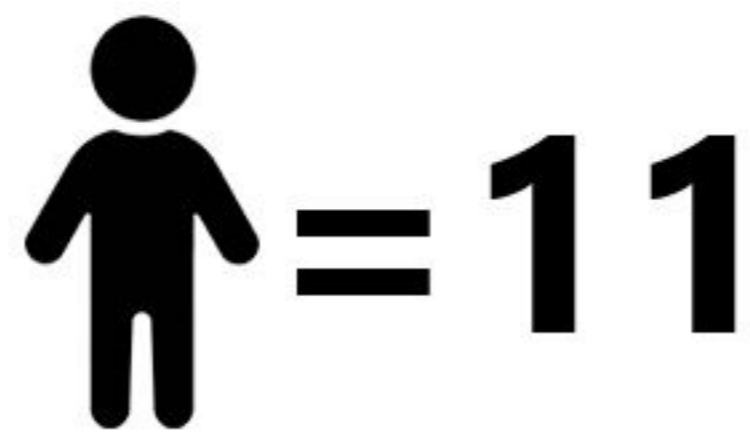




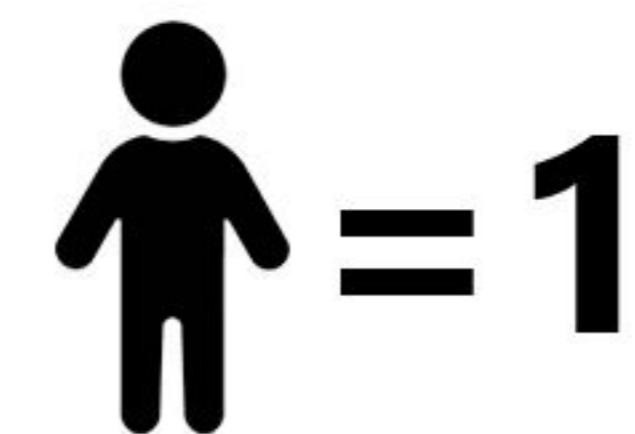

ECDs (Early childhood Development)



In 2022, the Home for Hope Foundation made significant strides in supporting 389 children under five years old through 22 Home-Based Education (HBE) groups. Our efforts extended beyond education, as we provided essential sanitation materials, including basins, jerrycans for drinking water, soaps, and toilet paper, ensuring a clean and safe environment for the children.

Additionally, we introduced a nutritious porridge breakfast, helping to meet the nutritional needs of these children and supporting their overall growth and development. This holistic approach continues to strengthen our mission of empowering vulnerable children in Rwanda.

Health Program

3 key pillars by 2022
of our Health Program:

- We supported access to health services by paying for health insurance.
- HFHF is intermediate between the Ministry of Health and Vitamin Angels to provide Vitamin A and Albendazole to more than 810,000 children.
- Sanitation and Hygiene (SAH).







Food & Nutrition Program

- We are empowering mothers through agricultural and other projects to increase their income generation.
- The Akira Project involves providing pigs to the most marginalized communities and poor families.
- We are working to combat stunting among children under the age of five.

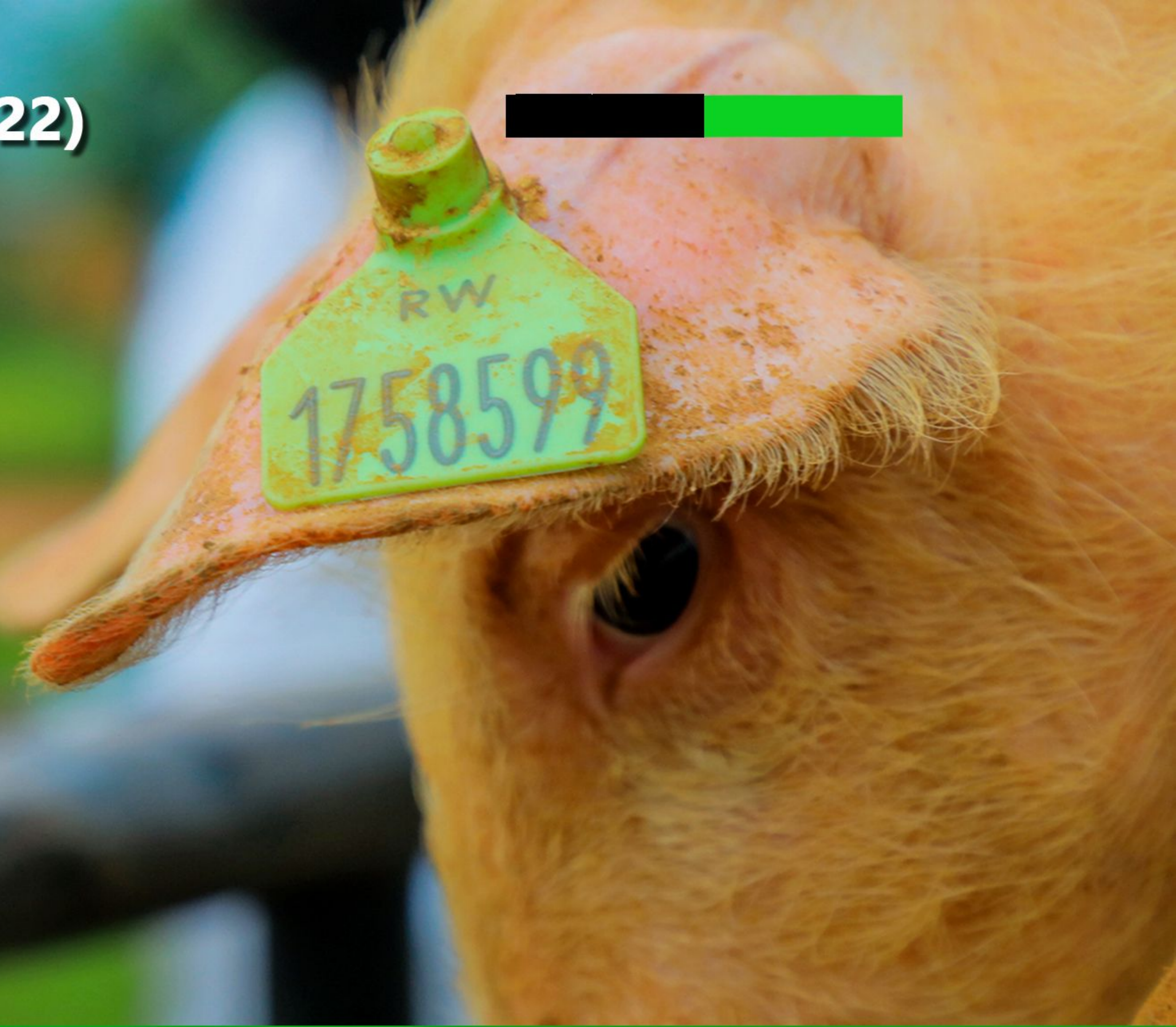

Akira Project has been made possible through the generous contributions raised during our annual online fundraising campaign held each December.





2022 Akira Project has impactful results, benefiting families in several ways:

- * **Health Insurance Access:** 15 families used income from the project to purchase full-year health insurance coverage.
- * **Improved Nutrition:** All 30 families have established kitchen gardens to grow vegetables, supporting efforts to reduce child stunting within their households.
- * **Enhanced Agricultural Yield:** Families have improved their harvests by incorporating organic compost, boosting sustainable agricultural practices.

These outcomes represent a significant step toward enhancing health, nutrition, and economic resilience for families in our community.

Food & Nutrition Program (Agriculture Project)

We have organized 30 mothers into two groups. One group consists of mothers whose children are supported by the Home for Hope Foundation's education program. These mothers, who are unable to afford school fees and have no stable income, are now embarking on a collective effort to cultivate agricultural and horticultural products. By 2022 We were honored by a visit of Melanie Foundation (Sponsors), who were deeply impressed by the progress.



In 2022, as part of our daily efforts, we actively fight against stunting in children under the age of five by providing essential hygiene and sanitation materials. This included distributing yellow jerrycans for safe drinking water, providing nutritious porridge (SOSOMA), soap, and educating the children on the importance of proper sanitation practices. These initiatives are crucial to promoting healthy growth and development among vulnerable children in our community.

Odenwald, organized a 12-day sponsorship cycling tour across Rwanda for 9 women from the Netherlands, at the request of the Melania Foundation. This was the second such tour, following a successful one in January 2020. The tour expanded support for the education program as the participants joined forces with the first group. This collaboration continues to make a significant impact, providing hope and opportunities for orphan and vulnerable children in Rwanda.
